Bedford's Danielle Churchill gives \$25,000 to build 9/11 Mount Kisco Memorial

Bedford resident Danielle Churchill was honored at the Mount Kisco Town Board meeting following her donation of \$25,000 to the Mount Kisco Volunteer Fire Department's 9/11 Memorial Fund. Members of the Mount Kisco Fire Department have organized a committee to build a memorial commemorating that day.

"I am here to give you a check for \$25,000 to help start the fund-

raising, and I hope other people will get involved and kick in," said Ms. Churchill.

"The memorial is our way to pay tribute," said Rich Alexander, co-chairman of the fund and a retired FDNY lieutenant. "This donation is a shot in the arm. For someone like Danielle to come along with this kind of donation is greatly appreciated."

The monument will be made of a pentagon-shaped base that will

act as a reflecting pool, with dark-granite pillars making up the twin towers of the World Trade Center. The project will be undertaken by volunteers in the construction business, such as Bedford Hills-based Westfair Pools. Manpower will be provided by Mount Kisco volunteer firefighters.
